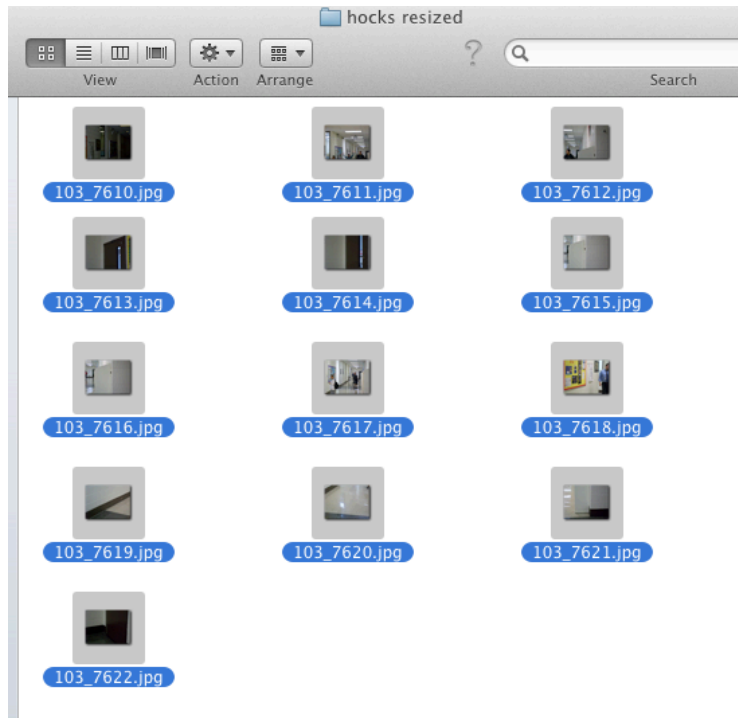
How to create your David Hockney
style collage in Photoshop

Step 1:

Create a folder for your Hockney pictures if you have not yet done so.

Step 2:

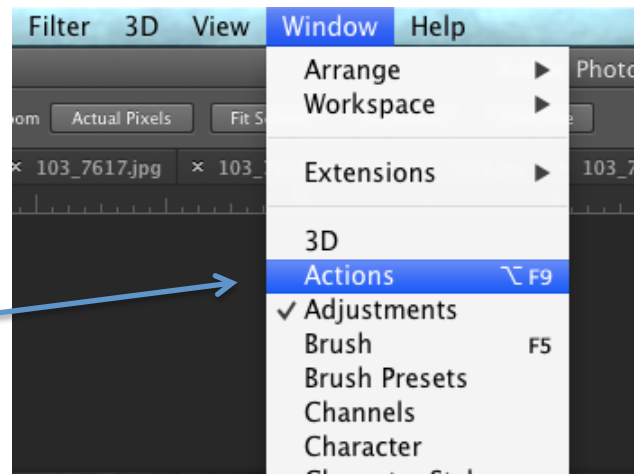
Click and drag across all of the pics in the folder.



Step 3:

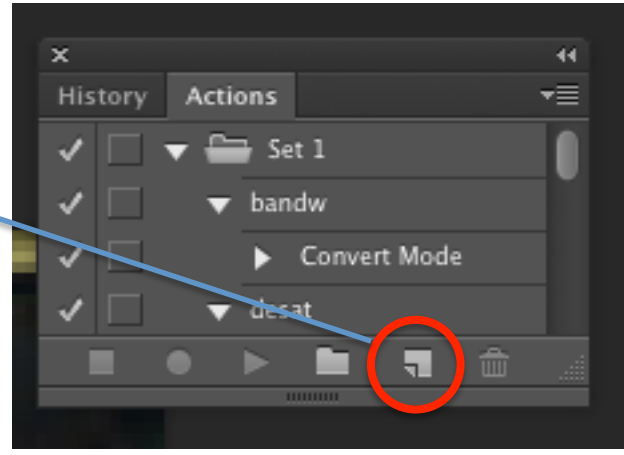
Drag pictures into Photoshop. Each picture will open in a new document.

Step 4:
Look at your screen in confusion.

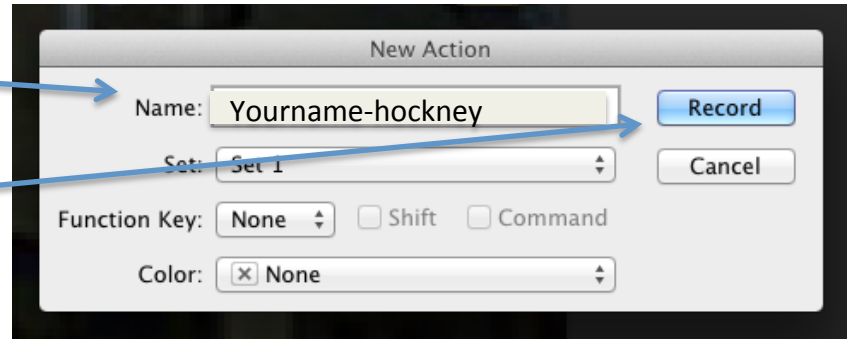


Step 5:
In Photoshop, go to Window > Actions

Step 6:
In the Actions toolbox, click on New Action.

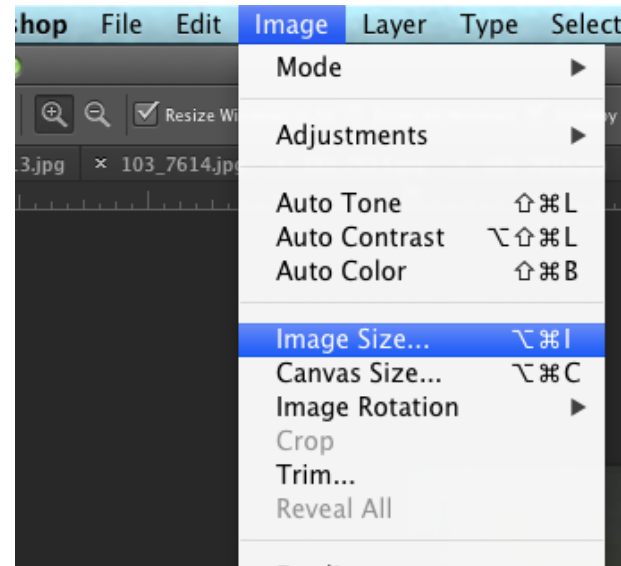


Step 7:
Name it yourname-hockney



Step 8:
Press Record

Step 9:
Go to Image > Image Size



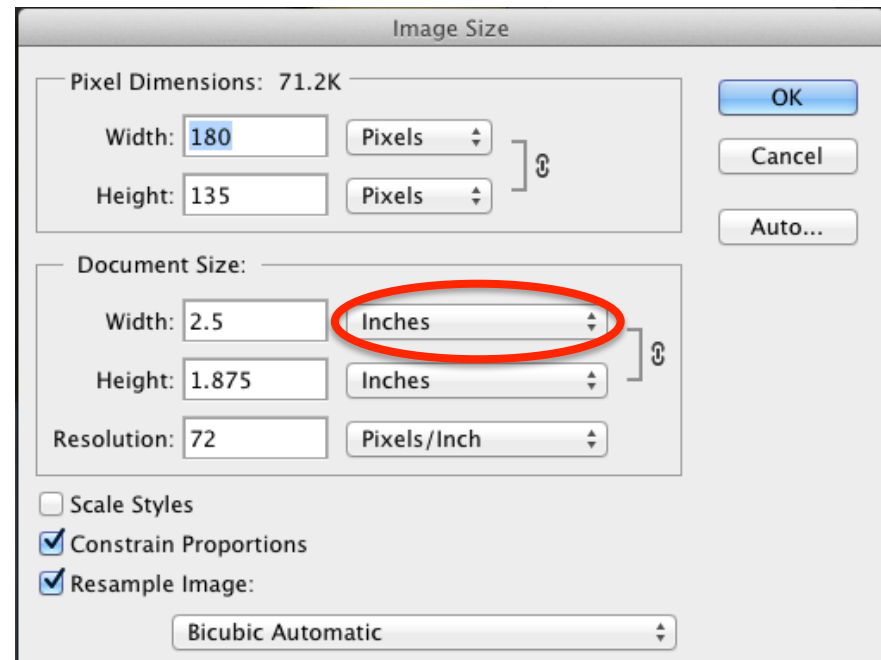
Step 10:

Enter in the dimensions:

Width = 2.5 INCHES
(Height will automatically change-)

Resolution: 72

Click OK

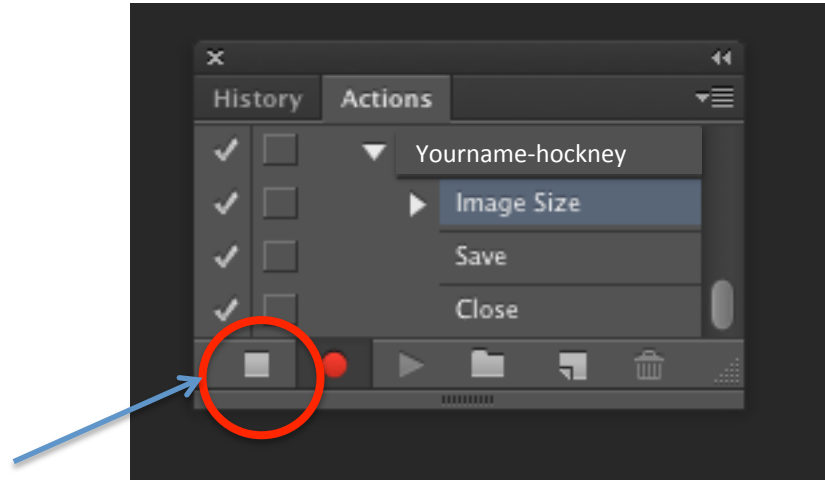


Step 11:

Go to File > Save
Go to File > Close

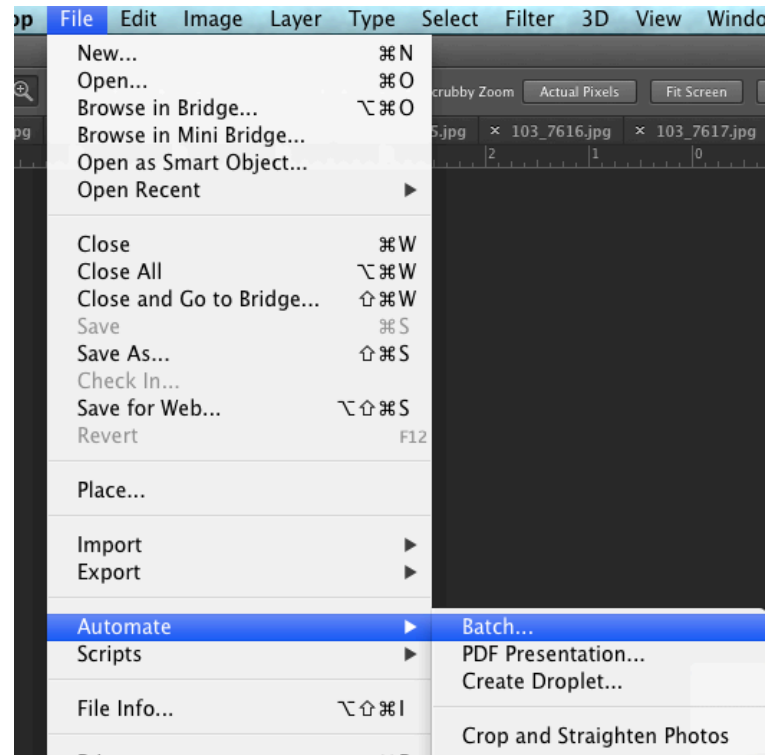
Step 12:

Click the Stop button in the Actions toolbox.



Step 13:

Go to File > Automate > Batch



Step 14:

Make sure
“yourname-hockney”
is chosen.

Change Source to “Opened
Files”

Click OK

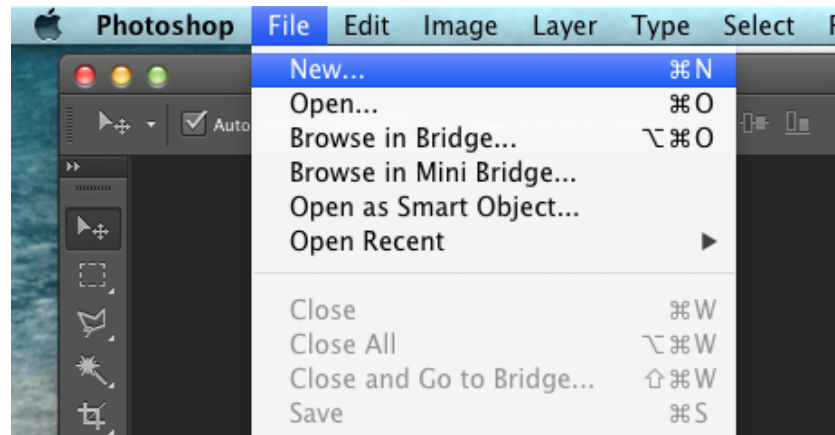

Step 15:

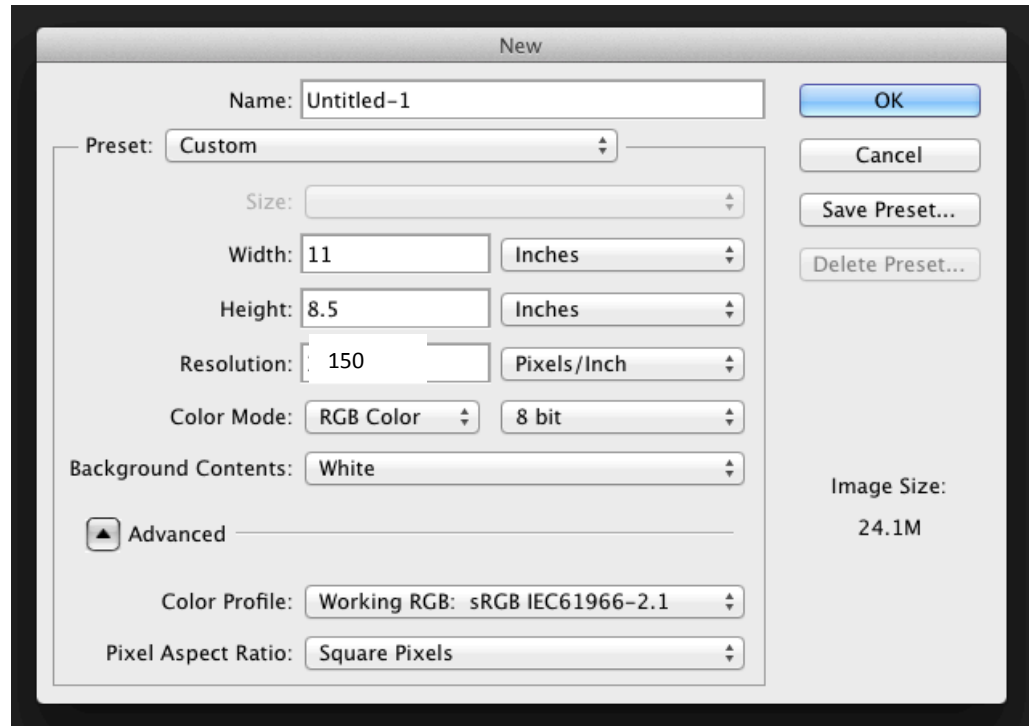
Go to File > New



Step 16:

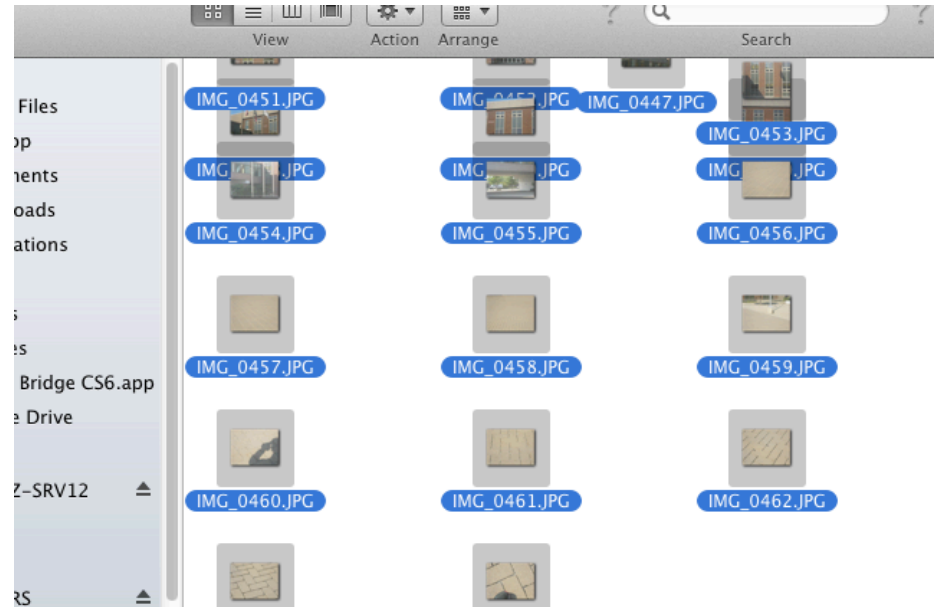
- Change the width to 11 inches
- Change the height to 8.5 inches
- Change the resolution to 150 ppi

Click OK



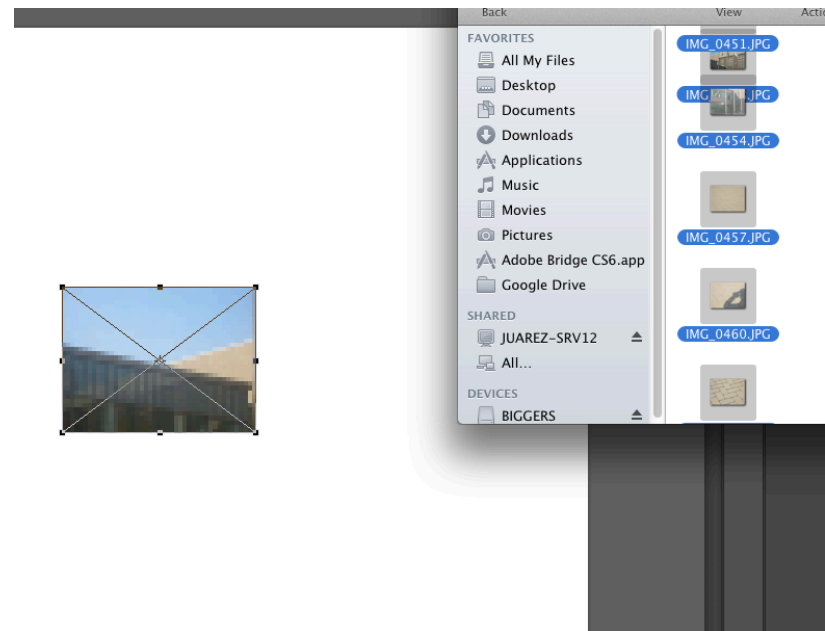
Step 17:

Go back to your folder with your hockney pictures. Select all the pictures by clicking and dragging across the files.



Step 18:

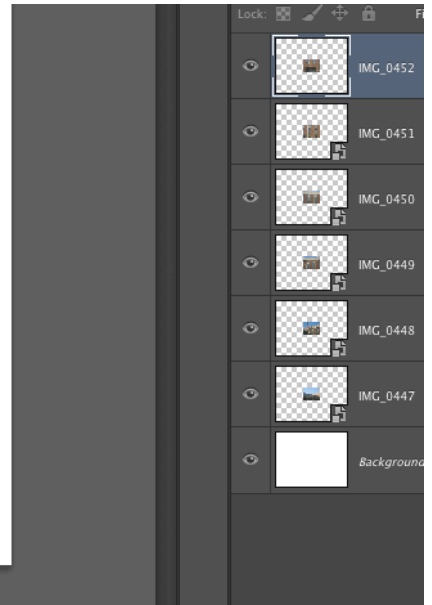
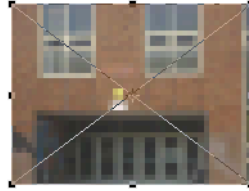
Drag all the files into the new Photoshop document.



Step 19:

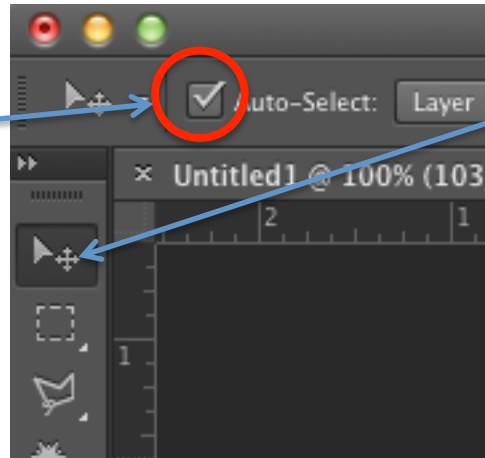
The pictures will only load one at a time. Notice how there is a light “x” across each picture.

Press the return key until all the pictures are loaded into layers.



Step 20:

Make sure “Auto Select” is checked.



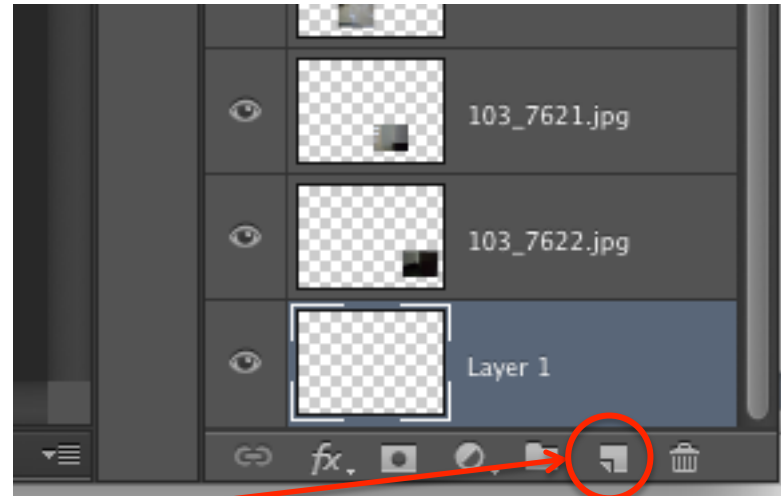
Step 20 ½ :

Arrange your pictures!
Make sure you use the Move tool (v).



Step 21:

If you have a lot of empty space around your pictures, or you need more space, use the crop tool to change the size of the document. Press return when you're done

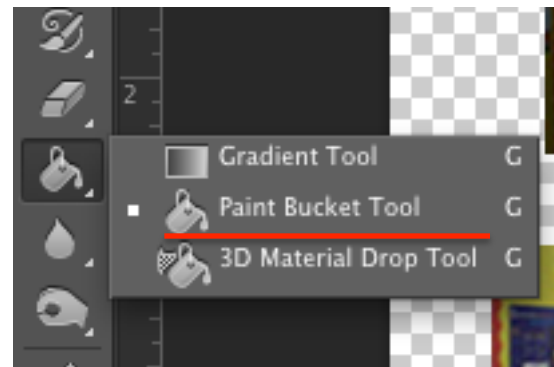


Step 22:

Make a new layer, and move the layer to the bottom.

Step 23:

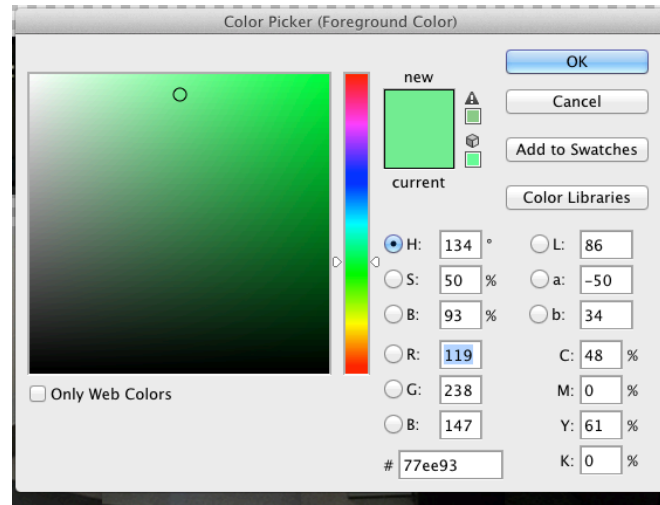
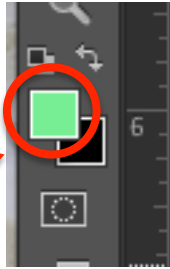
Choose the Paint bucket tool. (you might have to click and hold to get the Paintbucket tool, or press Shift G)



Step 24:

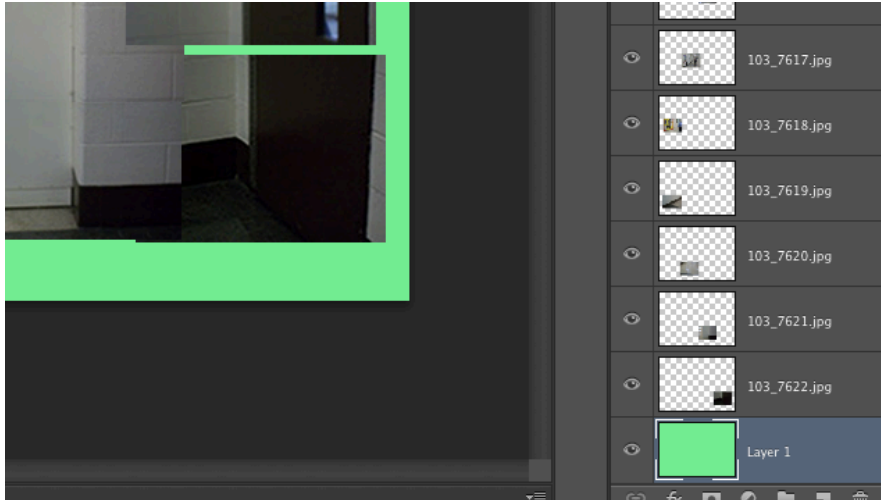
Double click on the Color Picker.

Choose a color, click OK.



Step 25:

Make sure your new layer is selected in the layers panel. Click anywhere in the document to paint the background. Make sure you are on the right layer.



Step 26:

Save as a jpeg and post on weebly: name_hockney1.jpg
